WHERE DID WE COME FROM??

In 1982, the Presbytery of Grand Canyon committed to the development of a new Presbyterian church in Gilbert, AZ. The current five-acre property of Gilbert Presbyterian Church (GPC) was purchased in 1982, and ground was broken in 1987, after several years of planning and fund-raising. The first worship service in the current building was held in April 1988. In 2000, a second building was erected to provide a venue for education, nursery care, and fellowship activities; the building was officially dedicated as The Palmer Center, in honor of Pastor Terry Palmer when he retired in 2019, after a long term of service.

WHO ARE WE??

The original church commissioned 112 charter members in 1984. Our membership numbers have risen and fallen since that time, and we currently have 196 members. Our members span all ages, and we pride ourselves on our inclusiveness.

Our church has now had 4 permanent pastors over the years, and we are ecstatic to have our new pastor, George Prohaska, who joined us in May of 2022. Preceding George was Dr. Terry Palmer, who served our church for 17 years.

In the Presbyterian tradition, GPC has two boards of elected officials. The board of deacons is composed of 12 members. Deacons are responsible for the care and nurture function of our church, and each is assigned responsibility for a "flock" of 8-10 families. The board of elders is also composed of 12 members. Elders are responsible for overall management of various church functions, including worship, Christian education, finance, personnel, buildings and grounds, evangelism, mission, and stewardship; committees have been established to accomplish each of these tasks, and additional task forces are created on an ad-hoc basis such as technology team, property management, resources, etc. We are a small, but mighty, church!!

WHAT DO WE DO??

Gilbert Presbyterian has weekly worship services on Sunday mornings at 9:30 AM. Worship services are also livestreamed on YouTube, Facebook, and GPC's website. Music is a meaningful part of worship, and our music ministry team oversees all aspects of music in worship, including the chancel choir, children's choir, and handbell choir.





ALL ARE WELCOME!!

New member's classes are held when individuals who have visited the church are interested in learning more about GPC, about the Presbyterian faith, and are considering joining. If you are interested in attending a class, please contact the church at 480-892-6753. Classes are held as needed in a small group with Pastor George on an on-going basis.

Christian Education classes for all ages are held at 11:00 AM. There are two different classes for adults (one a more traditional Bible study format, and the second a video-based class). Christian Education classes for younger children are held immediately following the children's message portion of the worship service. Newly renovated nursery and Pre-K rooms are available for our smallest of members through age 5.

HELPING OTHERS!!

Mission activities are important to GPC. We prepare lunches for East Valley Mens' Center, assemble nutrition packs for Feed My Starving Children, prepare and serve dinner at the UMOM homeless shelter, contribute to the needs of the Guadalupe Presbyterian Church, launder used clothing for the Heavenly Threads program, and provide gifts for needy children with the "Christmas Angel" tree.

Gilbert Presbyterian reaches out to our larger community by providing meeting space for support groups for those overcoming addictions, serving as a polling place for local elections, hosting blood drives several times a year, and making space available for homeowner association meetings.

We are part of a larger Presbyterian community, as part of the Presbytery of Grand Canyon, which includes 55 churches throughout Arizona. We also work with nearby Presbyterian churches to host a summer day camp program for children.

With our recent successful search for a new pastor, we have had the opportunity to reflect on our focus as a faith community. Thanks to Pastor George, we are in the process of identifying our priorities for a bright and fruitful future. GPC is constantly evolving with new forward-thinking ideas, and we would love to welcome you to join us on our journey!!
